



Ho Ho Ho Pillow

Skill Level: Intermediate



Finished measurements: aprox 11"x11"

Supplies:

- Charles Craft Gold Standard Aida 14 Ct 15 x 18
- 11.5"x11.5" fabric of your choice.
- DMC Embroidery Needle Size 8
- DMC Soft Cotton Art.89 # 2364
- 12" x 12" Pillow Form or Polyfill
- Fabric scissors
- Iron

STEP 1

Cut your aida fabric into an 11.5" x 11.5" square. Cross stitch the "HO" using DMC Matte Cotton. Please note that each square in the below chart denotes 4 squares on the fabric. This will makes the X's look big and chunky. To make it look even thinker, you can stitch over each X twice.

When you're done, place the front and back sides of the fabrics' right sides together.

Using your sewing machine*, sew a straight stitch. Sew three sides going around all the corners. Trim the extra fabric and join the corners after sewing.

*Note: If you don't have a sewing machine, don't worry. You can use a slip stitch instead.


Turn your pillow right side out. Iron your pillow flat.

Prepare the opening by tucking in your seam allowance and iron it flat.

Stuff your pillow using either an 12" x 12" pillow form or plenty of polyfill. Stitch the opening together with a tiny whip or blind stitch.
