

Knit Striped Baby Blanket

Level: Intermediate



FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 24"

Length: 31"

MATERIALS

Isaac Mizrahi® CRAFT™ Oz by Premier® Yarns
(100% Polyester; 100g/98yds)

- 3 skeins #IM2019-06 Scarecrow (A)
- 1 skein #IM2019-02 Wizard (B)

Needles/Hook: US Size 10 (6 mm) knitting needles, *or size needed to obtain gauge*

US Size 11 (8 mm) knitting needles

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

9 sts and 14 rows = 4" in Stockinette stitch

Save time, check your gauge.

PROJECT TIP

Weave in ends as you go to decrease time spent finishing.

STRIPE SEQUENCE

4 rows B

*6 rows A

2 rows B

Rep from * 3 more times

6 rows A

6 rows B

2 rows A

6 rows B

*6 rows A

2 rows B

Rep from * 3 more times

6 rows A

4 rows B.

STITCH PATTERN

Row 1 (RS): K1, p1, knit to last 2 sts, p1, k1.

Row 2 (WS): K1, p1, k1, purl to last 3 sts, k1, p1, k1.

Rep these 2 rows for pattern.

BLANKET

With larger needles and B, cast on 54 sts.

Change to smaller needle.

Knit 2 rows.

Begin Stitch pattern.

Work in Stitch pattern throughout, and change colors according to Stripe Sequence. Do not include the 2 knit rows already completed as part of the first stripe of B.

When Stripe Sequence is complete, knit 2 rows with B.

Change to larger needle. Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends and lightly block.

Abbreviations

k: knit

p: purl

rep: repeat

st(s): stitch(es)
