



SIZES

Childs size 4 (6, 8, 10)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Chest: 24 (26, 28, 30)"

MATERIALS

Deborah Norville™ Collection Everyday® Soft Worsted by Premier® Yarns (100% Anti-pilling acrylic; 113gm/203 yds)

Clown Fish

- ED100-12 Black (A) 1 ball
- ED100-01 Snow White (B) 1 ball
- ED100-22 Bittersweet (C) 2 balls

Blue Tang

- ED100-12 Black (A) 1 ball
- ED100-37 Fluorescent Yellow (B) 1 ball
- ED100-09 Royal Blue (C) 2 balls

Needles: US Size 8 (5 mm) circular needles 24" and 16" long *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Stitch holders, stitch markers, tapestry needle

GAUGE

19 sts x 24 rows = 4" in Stockinette Stitch

Save time, check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

This pullover is worked in separate pieces for the back, front and sleeves to the armhole. The pieces are then joined and the yoke is worked in the round to the neck.

PULLOVER

Back

With A, using longer needle, cast on 55 (59, 63, 67) sts.

Row 1 (WS): P1, * k1, p1; rep from * to end.

Row 2 (RS): K1, *p1, k1; rep from * to end.

With B, work 8 rows in k1, p1 ribbing as established.

With A, work 2 rows in k1, p1, ribbing as established.

With C, work in Stockinette stitch (knit the RS rows, purl the WS rows), until piece measures 6 (6½, 7, 7½)", ending with a WS row.

With A, work 2 rows in Stockinette stitch.
With B, work 8 rows in Stockinette stitch.
With A, work 2 rows in Stockinette stitch.
Place all sts on holder.

Front

Work same as Back.

Sleeves

With A, using longer needle, cast on 27 (27, 29, 31) sts.

Row 1 (WS): P1, * k1, p1; rep from * to end.

With B, work 8 rows in k1, p1 ribbing as established.

With A, work 2 rows in k1, p1, ribbing as established.

With C, work 2 rows in Stockinette stitch.

Next row – Increase Row (RS): K1, m1, knit to last st, m1, k1 – 2 sts increased.

Continuing in Stockinette stitch, rep Increase Row every 6th (6th, 8th, 8th) row 6 (7, 7, 7) more times – 39 (41, 43, 45) sts.

AT THE SAME TIME, when piece measures 6½ (7, 8, 9)”, work stripe as follows, continuing increases as needed.

With A, work 2 rows in Stockinette stitch.

With B, work 8 rows in Stockinette stitch.

With A, work 2 rows in Stockinette stitch.

Place all sts on holder.

Yoke

With C, using longer needle, k55 (59, 63, 67) sts from holder for back, place marker, k39 (41, 43, 45) sts from holder for left sleeve, place marker, k55 (59, 63, 67) sts from holder for front, place marker, k39 (41, 43, 45) sts from holder for right sleeve, place marker for beginning of round and join to work in the round – 188 (200, 212, 224) sts.

Next rnd – Decrease Rnd: * K1, ssk, knit to 3 sts before marker, k2tog, k1; rep from * to end – 8 sts decreased.

Continue in Stockinette stitch (knit every rnd), repeating Decrease Rnd every other rnd 15 (16, 17, 18) more times, changing to shorter needle when necessary – 60 (64, 68, 72) sts.

Collar

Rnd 1: With A, * k1, p1; rep from * to end, removing all markers except beginning of round marker.

Rnd 2: With A, work in k1, p1 ribbing as established.

Rnds 3-10: With B, work in k1, p1 ribbing as established.

Rnd 11: with A, work in k1, p1 ribbing as established.

Bind off in ribbing with A.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Sew side and sleeve seams. Weave in final ends.

Block lightly.

k	knit
k2tog	knit 2 stitches together (1 st dec'd)
m1	make 1 (1 st inc'd)
p	purl
rep	repeat
RS	Right Side
rnd(s)	round(s)
ssk	slip, slip, knit
st(s)	stitch(es)
WS	Wrong Side
